At the general meeting, Chair Otsuka was elected as the moderator and the results of activities and budget for FY2022 as well as proposed activities and budget for FY2023 were reported to and approved by the participants. ① Commemorative Lecture for the Society Award

As a commemorative lecture for the 2022 Society award, Mr. SUZUKI Tatsuo, representative director of the Artificial Sea Mount Institute Co., who received the award, gave a lecture titled "Proliferating natural fish in deep ocean water." SUSKI Tatsuo focused on the fact that natural seamounts supply nutrient salts from subsurface water (including deep ocean water) to the production layer, increasing the productivity of the surrounding organisms. With regard to increasing productivity, achievement have been accumulated through repeated theoretical studies and laboratory experiments. In this lecture, the method of installing artificial seamounts using post-building waste, etc. was introduced. He also proposed a recycling system that combined building demolition waste for seamounts.

② Keynote Lecture

Mr. FUNAMOTO Tsuyoshi, Deputy Manager, Kirakira Commerce and Tourism Division, Nyuzen Town, Toyama Prefecture gave a lecture on Nyuzen Town's "Urban Development utilizing DOW." In the lecture, Nyuzen Town and use of DOW in multiple stages at rice factories, oyster, and abalone farming facilities was introduced. In addition, new efforts are being made to take advantage of DOW such as cultivating salmon. He also announced the intake facility was expanded this year with the amount of water intake increased to 4,270m³/day. Offshore wind power plants are also progressing off the coast of the town, so the lecture included the SDGs initiatives of the town.
